

Campers attending Camp Gesher must abide by standards of conduct and behaviour. Campers who breach the Code of Conduct or break any of the program's rules will be dismissed from the program.

Campers must:

- Be an active participant in the entire program
- Abide by the rules set out by Camp Gesher's Mazkirut and professional staff
- Following our "screen free" policy, which states that any electronic device with a screen will not be allowed in Camp. If the chanichol chooses to bring a device with a screen, it will be confiscated. Camp Gesher assumes no liability with electronics brought to camp, including confiscated electronics. Any confiscated electronics will be return to the chanichol upon departure from Camp Gesher.

Grounds for dismissal include but are not limited to the following:

- Possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages or marijuana
- Possession and/or consumption of tobacco products, including e-cigarettes and vaporizers (even if there is no nicotine)
- Any involvement with narcotics or other street drugs, or misuse of drugs prescribed by a doctor or other medical professional
- Any destructive behaviour, as determined by Camp Gesher staff
- Repeated displays of disrespect for Camp Gesher staff, peers and/or the program
- Vandalism, destruction or any other criminal acts
- Endangering the mental or physical health of individuals

The decision to dismiss a camper for breaching this Code of Conduct is made by a Camp Gesher Director after careful consideration and in the best interests of the camper and Camp Gesher. Parents/guardians are responsible for the full cost related to sending a dismissed camper home. Parents/guardians will be notified of a dismissal and will pick-up their camper at a specified location.
